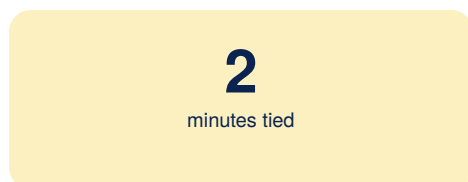

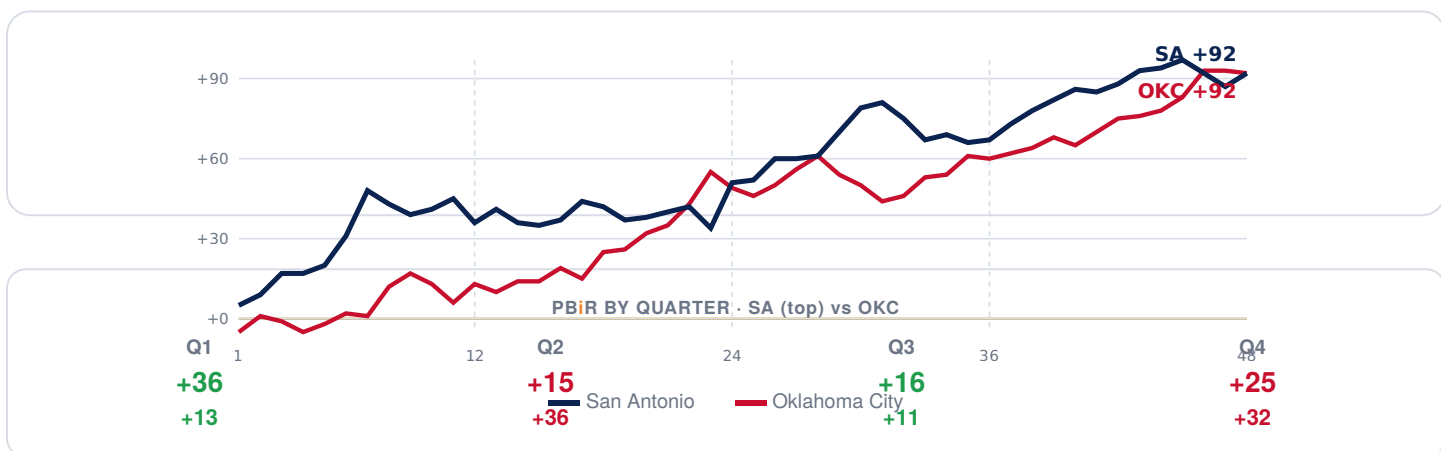


THE MINUTE WAR

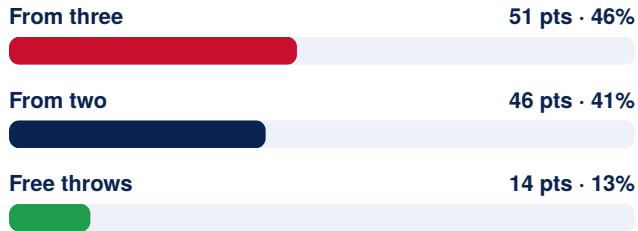

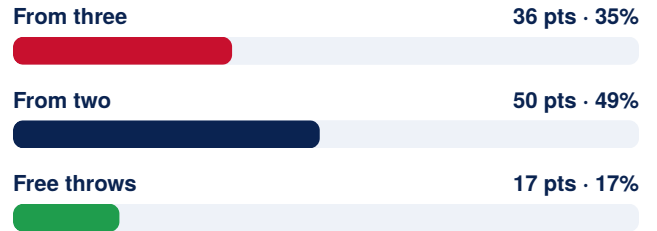

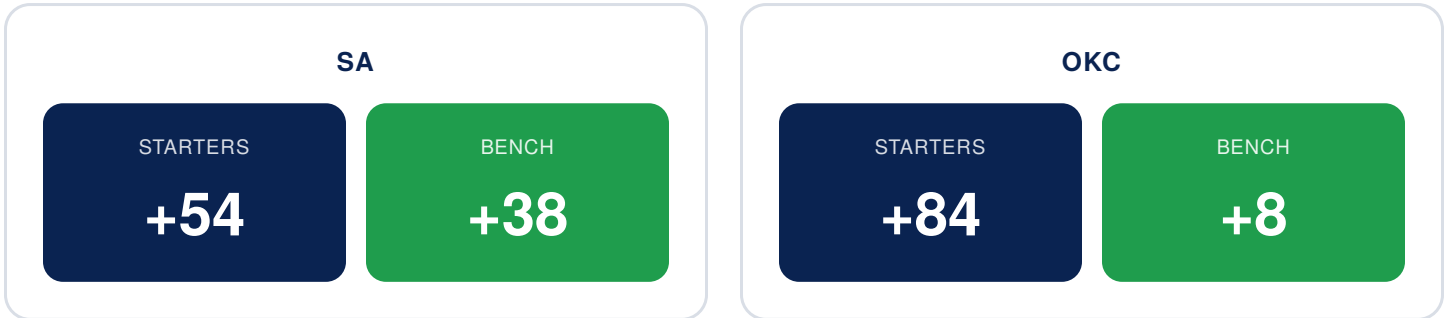

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THE WHOLE GAME IN PLAIN LANGUAGE

The Spoken Summary

San Antonio beat Oklahoma City **111–103** — an 8-point final. But the deeper story is the **minute war**: Oklahoma City actually won more minutes (24 to 22, with 2 tied) and the two teams finished **dead even in impact at +92 apiece**. What separated them was shot value — San Antonio scored 51 from three to Oklahoma City's 36, and out-produced them off the bench. Shai Gilgeous-Alexander was the night's top individual (+44), but San Antonio's depth — Harper, Champagnie, Wembanyama — won the minutes that decided the game. **Oklahoma City had the best player. San Antonio had the better possession profile.**
